“Shall the City of Norcross exempt from ad valorem taxation, stock in trade of a fulfillment center which, on January 1, is stored in a fulfillment center and which is made available to remote purchasers who may make such purchases by electronic, internet, telephonic, or other remote means, and where such stock in trade of a fulfillment center will be shipped from the fulfillment center and delivered to the purchaser at a location other than the location of the fulfillment center (the exemption provided for in this paragraph shall be for a period not exceeding twelve (12) months from the date such property is stored in this state, and such period shall be determined based on application of a first-in, first-out method of accounting for the inventory)?”
